

Dance Teacher / Coach Vacancy

Teacher required in the following styles: Freestyle & Basic Cheerleading.

(Street Dance an advantage) Various hours

Position involves teaching all age groups, ranging from Teenies to Young Adults.

Applicant must be reliable, dedicated, be able to work on own initiative, as part of a team, follow syllabus work for exams, and choreograph full routines for exams, competitions, festivals, shows and projects.

Employed positions are permanent and require applicants to be available to work Saturday's set hours below.

There is also extra availability to work during some school hours, and for after school clubs

The Successful applicant will be processed for an Enhanced Disclosure.

Teaching experience essential.

Job Description

There are two sides to the above Employed Position. Part of the role is to run and manage classes within the Dance School, whilst the other part involves teaching in local schools, colleges and out in the community.

Classes in the dance school involve:

Saturdays 9:00am – 1:30pm

Uni-Ted Movement to Music class: This is for 3-5 yr olds. It is an exam class working on a mix of styles, choreographing routines and being creative suitable to ages being taught. The class is also used as a 'feeder' to other classes for aged 6 and above students.

Teeny Cheerleading: 3-5yrs. This is an exam class, always consisting of routine work and choreographing the required amount of routines per grade for exams and following a syllabus for technique.

Teeny Freestyle: 3-5yrs. This is an exam class, always consisting of routine work and choreographing the required amount of routines per grade for exams and following a syllabus for technique.

Freestyle Disco (Beginners & Advanced): Age 6 - 15yrs. Exam class. No set syllabus to follow other than required amount of routines to be choreographed per grade

Competitive Freestyle: This class trains our Competitive Freestyle Pupils towards shows and competitions. The applicant must be competent in choreographing solo routines, slow, rock n roll, helping with pairs, and be prepared to give up free time and travel to various locations a few times per year to take the Pupils and Team to Competitions.

Freestyle Team Training: This class trains our Competitive Freestyle Teams (Junior and Senior) towards shows and competitions. The applicant must be competent in choreographing full team routines, and be prepared to give up free time, travel to various locations a few times per year to take the Team to Competitions

We will consider any applicant that is teaching dance for other providers as long as there is no possibility for time clashes with exams and shows.

The Company will pay for any Staff member under standard employment terms to take required courses.

The Applicant must be qualified in at least one dance style, or have expert knowledge and training,

This is a very demanding job with deadlines for projects, shows and exams. Applicants must be reliable, professional, dedicated, passionate and creative and be able to work as part of a team and from own initiative from home, have access to a computer and the internet, and be competent in Social Media, Facebook in particular where company accounts and pages will be provided for you to run.

Staff Members are expected to promote classes from home under the company's guidance and direction once per week.

Positions are employed, all insurance and licenses are covered by the company. Wages are paid on a monthly basis with full holiday pay entitlement and a pension scheme for qualifying employees.

The successful applicant will be processed for an Enhanced Disclosure at applicants own cost which will be deducted from first wage.



Wages are paid by calculating class takings in the school up to £20.00 per hour depending on qualifications.
Outside contracted bookings are paid between £17 - £25 per hour, depending on the area.
