



Street & Break Dance Teacher Vacancy

Dance Teacher required in the following styles: Street & Break Dance.

Various hours

Position involves teaching all age groups, ranging from primary schools up to University's.

Applicant must be reliable, dedicated, and be able to choreograph full routines for exams, festivals, shows and projects to a high standard.

Employed positions are permanent and require applicants to be available to work during school hours, and for after school clubs.

Successful applicants will be processed for an Enhanced Disclosure.

Teaching experience essential, however applicant will be fully trained by our company before commencing the position in full.

Job Description

There are two sides to the above Employed Position. Part of the role is to run classes within our Dance School, whilst the other part involves teaching out in the community.

Saturdays – 10:00am – 12:00pm – Battlehill Multi Use Centre

Baby Street Dance – Age 3-5yrs - 10am. Baby Break Dance- Age 3-5yrs – 10:30am. Street & Breakdance – Age 6+ - 11:30am

All Classes are just for fun and general dance development

Saturdays – 3pm – 5pm – Breakdance – Dance School

Break Dance: Beginners – 3pm – 4pm Intermediate & Advanced – 4pm – 5pm.

All classes are exam based, always consisting of routine work. Applicant must be fully competent in this style to train our advanced students.

The successful applicant will be working alongside Staff until fully trained

The second part of the job is during school hours and after school.

Sometimes the job involves following curriculum, other times PPA cover, Arts Awards, Apprenticeships, just for fun sessions or choreographing for festivals.

Travelling is involved for this side, the majority work is in the surrounding area, but travelling from school to school is involved and required.

All of our Staff also teach on our Dance Camps which run throughout the year.

As we are an exclusive provider, it is part of our employment contract that our Staff, do not teach for any other company offering dance, or teach freelance for themselves or others.

Our Company spends a lot of time and money training Staff members, CPD is attended on a weekly basis and is unpaid but compulsory. The Company will pay for, and send any Staff member to take required courses.

All staff are expected to attend any CPD being offered outside of the Company, details of which we will supply.

We however do not pay for Staff teaching qualifications.

The Applicant must be willing to take teaching exams in the subjects being taught.

The Company will train the Staff member to take examinations or send the staff member on the appropriate course to gain the qualification needed.

This is a very demanding job with deadlines for projects, shows and exams. Applicants must be confident in leading and delivering, be reliable, trustworthy, loyal, dedicated, passionate and creative.

Positions are employed. All insurance and licenses are covered by the company.

Wages are paid on a monthly basis.

The successful applicant will be processed for an Enhanced Disclosure at applicants own cost which will be deducted from wage.

Initial training will be for a maximum period of one month paid at minimum wage – 4-8 hours per week.

Saturdays (hours stated above) plus 4 hours shadowing existing Staff in Schools and out in the Community.

Once training is complete there will be base hours of 4 hours per week, (Saturdays) paid a percentage of the class takings up to £15 per hour depending on qualifications.

Outside contracted bookings are paid between £15 - £25 per hour depending on the area.

Applicants must also have some availability to work during and after school times.
